The Board of Certified Professional Ergonomist (BCPE) is the only ergonomic, human factors, and UX design certification in the United States that is recognized by the International Ergonomic Association (IEA).

The BCPE provides professional certification for practitioners of human factors/ergonomics (HFE) and UX design who demonstrate expertise and comprehensive understanding of the discipline.

Ergonomics International, LLC is the only organization that provides seminar and web-based preparation courses for the BCPE certification credentials. However, the seminar is available only by special request for companies and organizations who can fill a class.

Ergo-Online has been providing BCPE preparation training and mentoring since 1998. Recently, Ergo-Online, LLC was acquired by Ergonomics International, LLC and will continue to provide the same training and mentoring, with the same ownership, and with a revised and improved online training platform.

Our course and mentoring process is designed to provide each individual with a focused study plan based on their specific education, training and work experiences. What separates our web-based training from other online training is the one-on-one mentoring that we provide our participants.
